Field Work undertaken by 6th Sem Honours Course

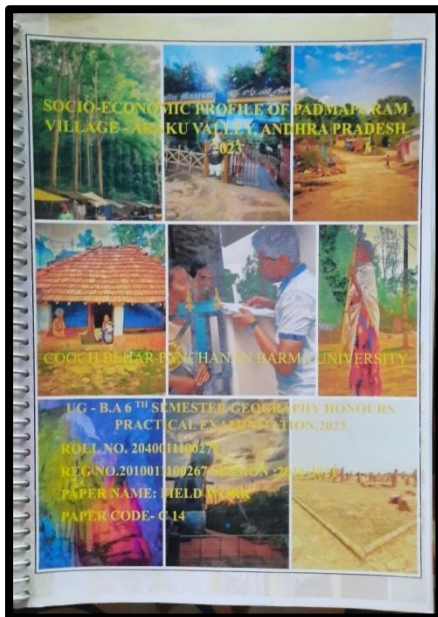

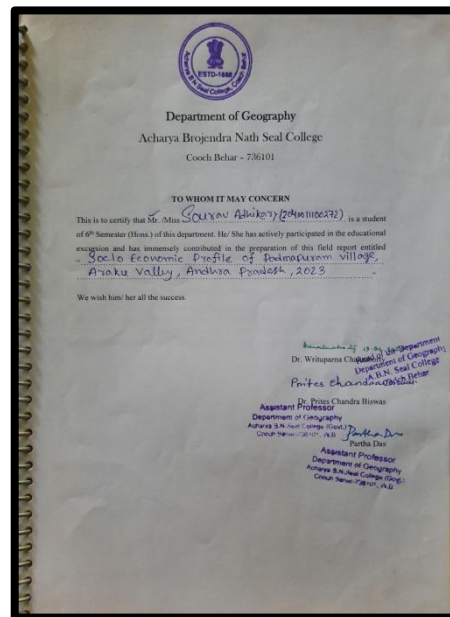

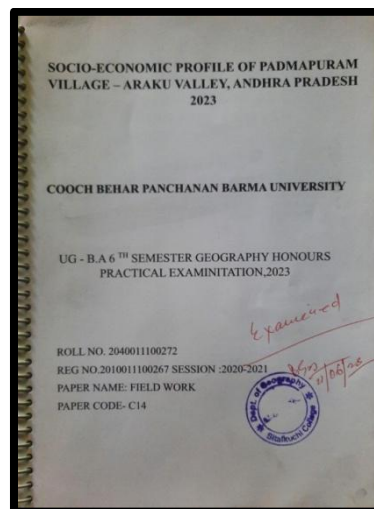
Cover Page of the Field Report



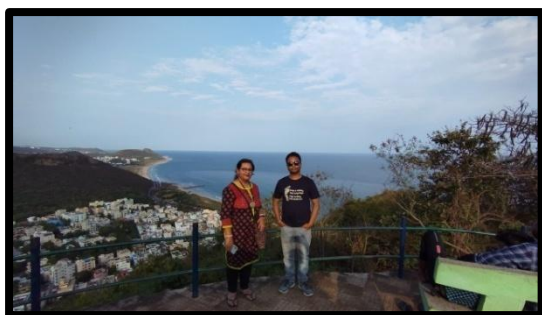
