#### **Field Works/Excursion:**

### 1. 31st March-3rd April, 2022 at Cooch Behar Municipality

The field survey was conducted in March, 2022 as a fulfillment of a portion of the Final Semester Geography Honours Syllabus under UG CBCS Curriculum of Cooch Behar Panchanan Barma University. The aim of the study was to explore and analyze the detailed socioeconomic conditions of different wards of Cooch Behar Municipality based on the collected data. Total 900 samples were collected by 19 students of 6<sup>th</sup> semester on different socio-economic parameters. Result of the study revealed some interesting facts. In general, ward no 12, 13, 14, and 17 were found to be in better position regarding different socio-economic parameters whereas the 2, 3, 6, 8 and 18 wards were far behind than those wards. This report can be used for the planning and policies for the development of the municipal area. It has also the potential to be an important document for future researchers and history of Cooch Behar municipality.
