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Brief History of the College

Acharya Brojendra Nath Seal¹ College has a chequered history of more than 130 years. It was founded in 1888 by Maharaja Nripendra Narayan, the then ruler of the Princely State of Koch Bihar and an enthusiast in expanding the culture of learning in this region. The Maharaja originally named the College after Queen Victoria (Victoria College) to commemorate the 50 years of the Queen's coronation. It is worthwhile to mention here that, Maharaja Nripendra Narayan was married to Sunity Devi, daughter of Sri Keshav Chandra Sen, a leading social reformer, educationist and the pioneer leader of Brahmo Samaj movement, during the Renaissance Period of Bengal. Sunity Devi along with her husband took keen interest in developing the academic atmosphere in this region which resulted in the foundation of Victoria College as a centre of higher studies. Incidentally after the independence of India, the Princely State of Koch Bihar came under Bengal Presidency in 1948 (it was finally merged with West Bengal on the 1st January, 1950) and Victoria College was also taken over by the Government of West Bengal.

The founder Principal of the College was Prof. J. D. Goodley who served the Institution from 1888-89. After a short



stint of Principalship of two other Principals from abroad, Prof. Wood and Prof. Delafosse, Acharya Brojendra Nath Seal was the first Indian to grace the chair. He was at the helm of affairs of the College for 18 long years (1896-1913). Acharya, besides being one of the greatest philosophers and thinkers of modern India, was a pioneer in the field of higher education in Bengal and set the example of simple living and high thinking. A Ph. D. and D. Sc. from Calcutta University in 1910 and 1915 respectively, Brojendra Nath Seal was appointed as George V Professor of Philosophy in 1914 (Renamed later on after Brojendra Nath in 1950). He was appointed as Vice-Chancellor of Mysore University. It was Professor Seal who at the request of Tagore, inaugurated Viswa-Bharati in Santiniketan. In 1926 Knighthood have been conferred upon him. Under his stewardship, the College became famous as a centre of learning not only in Bengal but also in the whole of North-East India. During that period, the College was not only known for its undergraduate teachings but also known for its postgraduate department in English. Apart from this, the College conducted Bachelor of Law classes too.

Acharya Brojendra Nath Seal was succeeded by T. L. Vaswani as the Principal of the College. Professor Vaswani was one of the earliest supporters of Mahatma Gandhi's Non-Cooperation Movement and a close associate of Mahatma. Later on, he moved across the length and breadth of India, inculcating national consciousness. In 1933 he founded the Mira Movement in Education which stressed on the cultural value of India combined with the modern scientific spirit of inquiry.

Prof. Chandrika Prasad Banerjee of the discipline of History was the Principal of this college from 1957-1959. Incidentally, he was the son of great historian Prof. Rakhaldas Banerjee. Another stalwart who graced the chair of the Principal of this College was Prof. Bhabatosh Dutta (1975-1977). He was renowned scholar in Bengali literature and later on became the Vice-Chancellor of Viswa-Bharati. Prof. Pradip Mukherjee, a famous Geologist, and who acted as Principal of this College from 1969-1970, moved on as Registrar, Calcutta University and subsequently became Pro-Vice-Chancellor of Jadavpur University. Victoria College and subsequently Acharya Brojendra Nath Seal College can also boast of a number of celebrated faculties at different points of time. During the period from 1888-1930, Prof. Joykrishna Sen of the Department of English, Prof. Govinda Chandra Das of the then Department of Science, Prof. Jogesh Chandra Sinha Roy of Philosophy, Prof. Sarat Gupta of Sanskrit, Prof. Rajat Prasad Neogi of Mathematics, Prof Bir Chandra Sinha of Philosophy, Prof. Jotish Chandra

Bhadra of Mathematics, Prof. Lalit Banerjee of English, Prof. Kapileswar Sastri of Sanskrit are few such distinguished faculties. During the period of 1930-1950, scholars like Prof. Phani Bhusan Chatterjee of Chemistry, Prof. Sarat Chandra Gupta and his brother Prof. Amulya Chandra Gupta (both of them) taught English and the latter was an alumni of this College too. Amulya Chandra Gupta's book on Rhetoric and Prosody is considered a valuable work in English language. Prof. Pratul Chandra Rakshit, a famous scholar on thermodynamics was also a faculty of this College during the forties. He had left a glowing account of his experiences in Cooch Behar. Prof. Debendra Kumar Ghosh served this College in the Department of Bengali. His book on History of Bengali Literature is listed in the Calcutta University. Prof. Chunilal Mukherjee of Economics and Prof. Durga Kinkar Bhattacharjee of English who incidentally were alumnus of this College, protested against the army deployment by the Maharaja in collaboration with the British Government at Cooch Behar in 1943. Prof. Durga Kinkar Bhattacharjee moved to Malda College as the Principal and later on he joined in the C. P. I. In the fifties of twentieth century, Prof. Sashi Bhusan Das and Prof. Santiranjana Banerjee of English (later moved to Burdwan University), Prof. Ganesh Chandra Bose (came from Dacca University and joined Jadavpur University), Bhabani Gopal Sanyal of Bengali (a famous writer), Kamal Kumar Ghatak of History (moved to Calcutta University) were eminent faculties of this College.

In recent past, the college have been blessed with some eminent faculties like Tarapada Chatterjee of Physics, Barnik Roy of Bengali, Prasanta Kumar Ghosh of Political Science (An exponent on Constitution), Dilip Kanjilal of Sanskrit, Basanta Samanta of Mathematics, Kaushik Biswas of Botany, Rampada Bhattacharjee and Bimal Chatterjee of Zoology.

The College produced outstanding alumni right from its establishment. Raisaheb Panchanan Barma was a famous educationist and social reformer. He passed F. A. from Victoria College in 1891 and B. A. in 1884. After passing M.A. from Calcutta University, he graduated in Law from Victoria College. It is pertinent to mention here that Panchanan Barma was the first M. A. and Law graduate from Cooch Behar.

Pulin Bihari Das, a revolutionary in Pre-independent India, passed F. A. in 1899 from this College. Famous social activist, politician and writer of this area, Upendranath Barma was a student of this College from 1916-1920. Famous Folk (Bhawaiya) song exponent Abbasuddin Ahmed passed B.A. from Victoria College. In the forties of the twentieth century, Sourin Bhattacharya who became a leader of the Revolutionary Socialist Party was a student of this college. His brother Ramen Bhattacharya who later on became a Borough Chairman in London was also an alumnus. Sri Haraguri Gupta who became a Professor in Canada, was a student of this college. Amit Roy and Ashok Roy an engineer and a M. R. C. O. G (London) settled in Canada and London respectively, were also students of this College.

Famous Bengali novelist Shirsendu Mukherjee studied I. A. in this College. Sri Sukhbilas Barma, I. A. S. and a famous Bhawaiya singer was a student and faculty of this institution. Prof. Prahlad Sarkar of Philosophy in Calcutta University, Prof. Sankar Kumar Bhowmik of Economics in Calcutta University, Prof. Hari Madhab Sarkar of Linguistics in Jawarhalal Neheru University were the students of this institution. Finally Atreyi Ghosh of Chemistry (now a faculty in Alabama University, USA) is the alumna of this College.

The great history and tradition of the College and its continuing contribution to the field of education in the region was recognized by the UGC in 2010 when it accorded on the College, the honour of being a Centre with Potential for Excellence. The accreditation of the College with Grade A by The National Assesment and Accreditation Council in 2017 has also added a feather in the Crown of the institution.



PROLIFERANT ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN:

Administrative Activities

(i) Activity of Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

The IQAC of any institute is a “participative” and “facilitative” unit that works in association of the college authority and faculty members so as to plan out the best possible strategies for the institutional development.

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Acharya Brojendra Nath Seal college has been functioning all round the year in order to achieve the goal of action plans for quality evaluation, quality sustenance and quality up-gradation of the institute. Accordingly the cell has been making concerted efforts to motivate and guide the students, teachers and non-teaching staff of the college for holistic quality excellence. Some of the most important quality enterprises taken up by the IQAC are the instigation and assessment of the students’, teachers’ and other stakeholders’ feedback, being a regular affair of the IQAC, even amongst all adversities; extension of services in various forms benefiting the students of the college as well as the society at large , providing continuous impetus for the organization and celebration of major observable Days such as the International Yoga Day, World Environment Day, International Womens’ Day to name a few. Observation of Annual Day of the College and publication of Annual Report, ‘SAMAY’ on that very day, which happens to be a narrative containing all undertakings and accomplishments of the college , students, teachers and staff ,well reflects the insight and judiciousness of the IQAC.

(ii) Report on Vaccination Programme

In the year 2020, the corona virus caused a Pandemic in the entire world. Acharya B. N. Seal College, Cooch Behar successfully completed Free Coveseild Vaccination Camp in collaboration with District Administration, Cooch Behar for bonafide students, teaching and non-teaching staff of our college. The 1st dose of Covid-19 vaccine was given on 29.09.2021 and 2nd dose was given on 23.12.2021. The total number of beneficiaries including students, teaching and non-teaching staff were, 592 for 1st dose and 511 for 2nd dose.

(iii) Kanyashree Prokalpa

Kanyashree Scheme’s core objectives are simple and focused: it aims to ensure that girls stay in academic institution and delay their marriages till at least the age of 18. Kanyashree’s approach is also simple: it uses a social safety net mechanism that has shown a high degree of success in transforming the lives of children and adolescents in our State.

(v) Renovation Works and Beautification of College Premises

Extensive civil works including painting of rooms are in progress at different parts of the college mainly the Library, Girls' Hostel, Boys' Hostel. Cleaning of weeds is a regular affair along with repairing and clearing of the drainage pipes of the college. Concrete benches have been installed at different parts of the college for students to sit during leisure hours. The gardens of the college have been beautified by weed clearance and fencing. Enclosures have also been put up around the Medicinal Herb garden, adjacent to the Department of Botany. Different medicinal plants have been planted in this garden. Boards with site maps of the college have also been installed for students' convenience. The college premises have been restricted from movement of any type of vehicles including bicycle.

Thorough repairing of wooden furniture including benches was also done. Basins and tap for supply of water were also installed for students at different departments. Complete Electrical works were done in the Department of Chemistry.

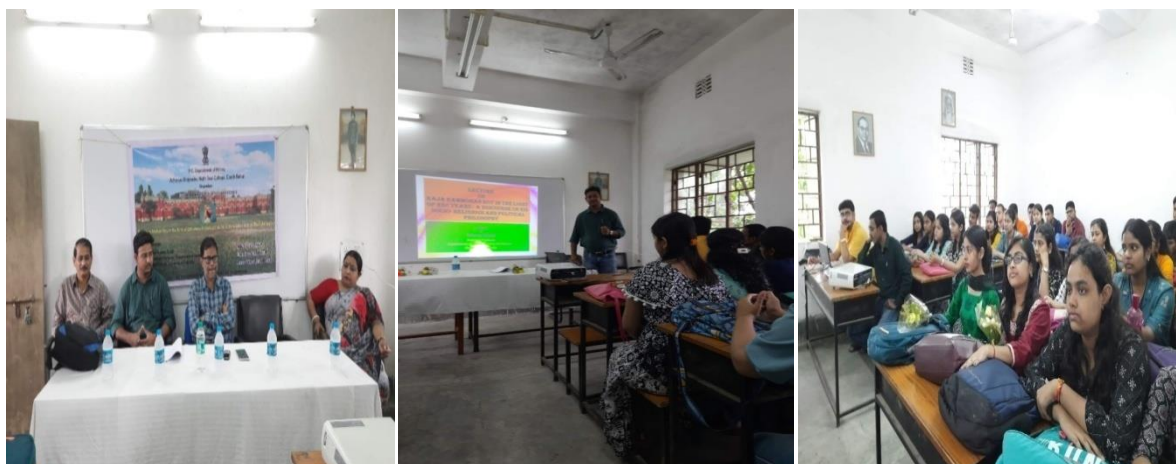

(ii) Memorial Lectures/ Invited Lectures

All the Departments of this College organized Memorial/ Invited Lectures in their respective Departments to enlighten and motivate their students by the valuable talks from the eminent scholars and personalities from their subject area.

(iv) Students’ Seminar

All the Departments of this College organized Student’s Seminar in their respective Departments. The main objective of this activity was to accustom students with the modern day teaching-learning techniques as well as to instigate innovative thinking within their minds.

(v) Publication of Journal

The College publishes peer reviewed journal: The Victorian Journal of Arts (ISSN 0975-5632). This journal is published twice a year and contains scholarly articles contributed by authors with multifarious acedmic pursuits.

(vi) Educational Tours

Educational tours are essential for the understanding of everyday situations by the students in a real time frame where they can test their learnt knowledge and make sure they are future prepared. Different Departments arrange the educational tours after discussion with their respective students about the feasibility and prospect of such tour at a proposed area. The students are involved intimately with the process of arrangement of such excursion. Due to COVID-19 Pandemic, it was not feasible to conduct educational field study or tours during 2021-2022.

(vii) Skill and Job Potential Development Cell

The cell organized several career oriented webinars/seminars/ workshops in collaboration with State level and National level skill development agencies, like ICA, RICE Education, TCS, Anudip Foundation and others. A number of beneficiary students selected by the agencies are being trained in respective institutes.

(viii) Launching of Add-On Courses in different departments

An add-on course essentially provides an additional insight into the area of interest of the students related to a subject but beyond their stipulated course of study. It covers area(s) of interest and professional utility that would help a student in future. These courses help the students to gain knowledge even beyond the stereotyped horizons and thereby builds their interest in pursuing the subject in future.

Keeping these thoughts in mind, Acharya Brojendra Nath Seal College, Cooch Behar, being inspired and steered by the IQAC, organized various Add-on courses for their students. The time slot for each course was set for seven to ten days, (not less than 32 Hours) and the number of aspiring participants were fixed by respective departments, depending on the course structure. The resource persons were chosen by respective departments, either from other institutes or from their own departments.

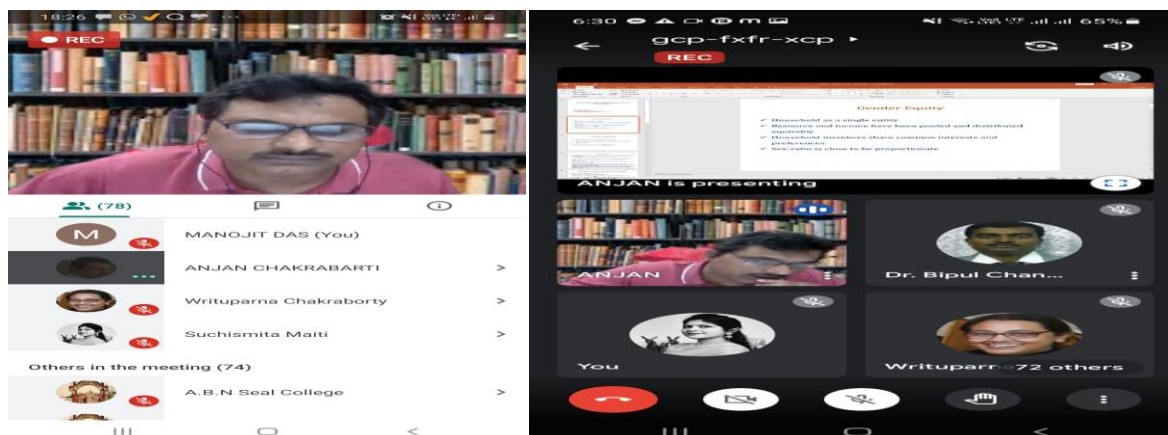
(iii) Student Week Observation

It consisted of three Technical Sessions. His topic was “Outcome-Based Curriculum Design”.

The prime objective of this workshop was to nurture the philosophy of Outcome-Based Education (OBE) and build the capacity of the Faculty Members and Academic Administrators for facilitating its institutionalization in the Teaching Learning System and other academic processes of the Institution. The proposed workshop addressed various pros and cons such as the concept of Outcome-Based Education, OBE framework and its components, outcome and its impact on NAAC Metrics, Graduation Attributes, Educational Objectives, Programme Objectives, Programme Specific Objectives, Course Objectives and how they are interlinked with one another, COs Mapping, Guidelines for COs, Blooms Taxonomy, the methodology of restructuring the present curriculum to suit OBE etc.

(vii) Inaguration of Incubation Centre for Innovative Ecosystem

Like a baby is nurtured, Incubation centres provide facilities to nurture young firms during their early months or years of growth. Through the incubation centre, students gain hands-on experience in innovation while being nurtured and encouraged by faculty, management and industry experts. With this background information, A.B.N. Seal College, Cooch Behar established an “***Incubation Centre for Innovative Ecosystem***” in collaboration with CII, North Bengal, for facilitating the student community of this region. Through this initiative, the student community can share their innovative ideas and can initiate a start up in the future. In this connection, an inaugural ceremony followed by a talk on “Sensitization of Govt. Scheme and Business Model under MSME” was held on 06.11.2021. The inaugural session was presided by Hon’ble District Magistrate, Cooch Behar. Sri Sanjoy Tibrewal, Chairman, CII, North Bengal Chapter, Smt. Laxmi Kaushal, Zonal Head, CII, North Bengal Zone were present in the inaugural session. Besides it, the said centre arranged an interactive lecture session on Start up scheme on 02.12.21. Extension and Social Activities

(i) National Service Scheme (NSS)

The College has a very active NSS wing, which performs laudable activities to help the students grow into better citizens of tomorrow. - Speech on the value of tree plantation as

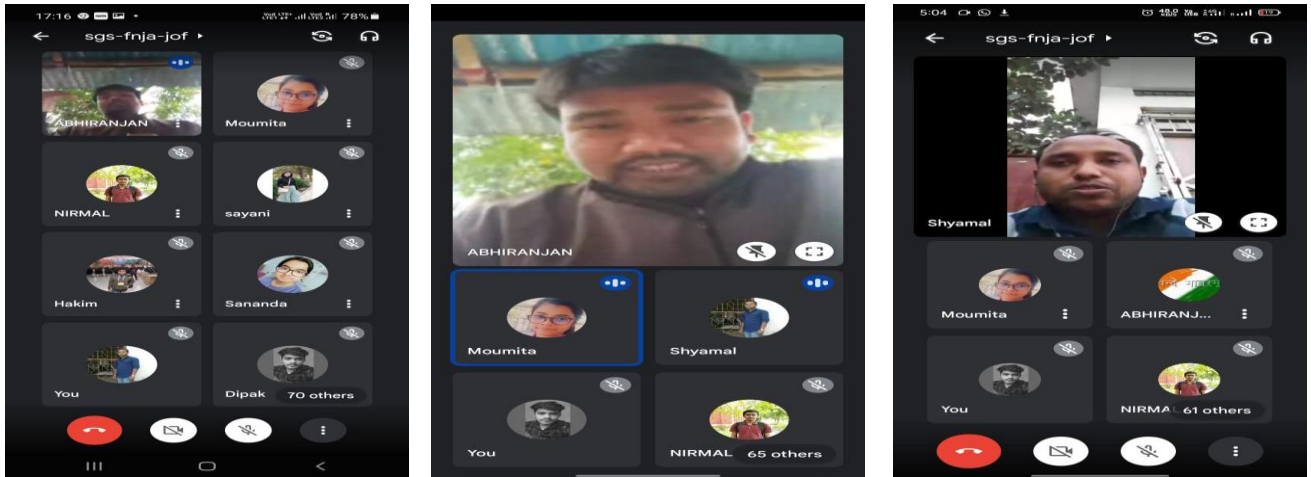

(iii) Games and Sports Activities

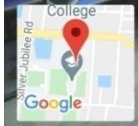

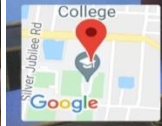
Our students participated in both University sports meet and state meet during this year.

Activities of Library

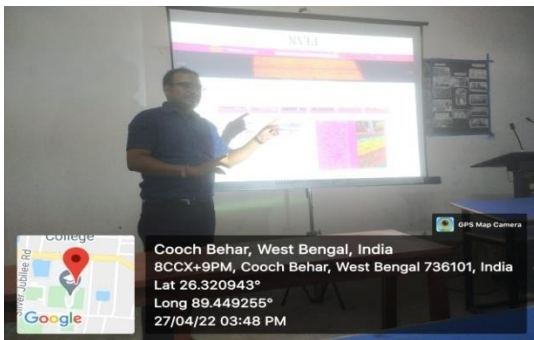

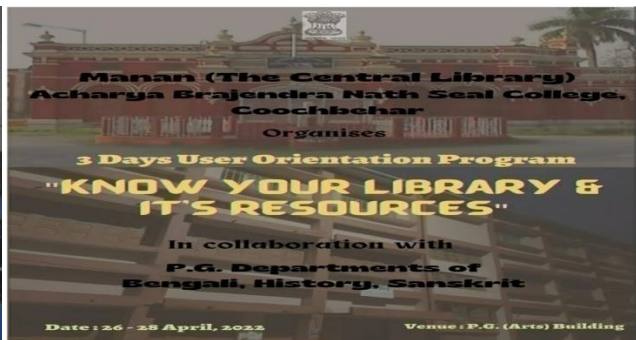

Physiology is a very promising Science subject, especially concerning human beings. It has both theoretical and practical papers. The Department of Physiology of A. B. N. Seal College has been started as a new department in the Academic Session 2013-2014. This department was started in this college with the introduction of B. Sc. 3-year Degree Course in Physiology in Honours stream with an intake capacity of 20 (twenty) students and 5 (five) permanent teaching posts in W.B.E.S. by the approval of Department of Higher Education, Government of West Bengal.

CENTRAL LIBRARY

RESOURCES AND ACTIVITY

The Cooch Behar Victoria College was established in the year 1888. On the day of 15th June 1888 the College officially started its journey. From that very year the College was granted Rs. 10,000/- as a special grant for building its infrastructure including Library, Furniture & Laboratory etc. In the next year the College received Rs. 2000/- under the same head.

There were two buildings, made with the help of British Architecture for the Britishers, in the heart of the city on the East of the Bairagi Dighi. From 1879-80 Ms/ Merrilier Company and Edwards had started to build a luxurious palace for the then Cooch Behar Maharaja and his family. The above mentioned buildings were the abode of the English architects and other staff, who came to supervise the construction work. In 1887 the British Architects returned to their home after the palace was completed. Then the Company sold those two buildings to the Cooch Behar Royal Authority in 20,000 rupees. Those buildings are the birthplace of the Victoria College. In the month of June of 1888, the College was started in those buildings. In 1894 – 95 the Veranda of the second building was covered with glass and turned as the first library of the college.

In the first phase (1889 – 90) The College Clerk performed the duty of the College Librarian. In 1926 the Central Hall of the present main building of the College was converted to College Library as well as Students' Reading Room.

Since the 1st January 1950 the Victoria College became a government college under the Government of West Bengal. The staff pattern of the College of that year showed one post of Librarian.

A three-storied building was started to be constructed in the memory of Acharya Brojendra Nath Seal in his birth centenary. The building was completed in the year 1969 and named as 'Acharya Brojendra Nath Seal Centenary Block'. In 1973 the Physics Department, Mathematics Department and Library were shifted in that newly made block.

The Central Library of the College was finally shifted to a two-storied building in the north-west side of the College campus in July 1999.

At present the Central Library consists of the following sections :

- Acquisition & Processing Section
- Lending Section
- Reference Section
- Reading Room for Students
- Reading Room for Teachers
- Library Repository
- Civil Service Study Centre

Along with the Central Library, there are fifteen (15) Seminar Libraries in different Departments of the College.

The elevation of the Central Library Building has been completed. The Central Library is going to open its spacious reading room and digital library section in the 2nd floor very soon.

The Library Repository has been extended. The library has started to collect year-wise data from all the departments of the college. The library has previous years question paper repository.

Library Automation was started in 2016 with the CPE Fund. Koha integrated Library Software was purchased along with a Library Server. This year we are planning to expand our automation process.

Selective Dessimination of Information (SDI) Service and Current Awareness Service of newly arrival books have been started from this year among the faculty members.
