This is to intimate you that ABN Seal College has taken feedback from its esteemed faculties and alumni on the syllabi in the session 2020-2021. In this connection I'm submitting the summary of the feedback for your kind consideration and necessary action.

The feedback from students reveals that students are mostly satisfied with the syllabi and allied questions. Although, the feedback showed that there are scopes for modifications of syllabi so as to make it helpful in students' seminar.

From the responses of the alumni it was evident majority of the alumni consider the syllabi are capable of imparting subject specific knowledge of the students. Although, it is noteworthy that a considerable section of alumni think that the syllabi requires to be updated to make it more job-oriented.

On the teachers' counterpart of feedback, majority of the teachers expressed their overall satisfaction on the present syllabi and thought that the syllabi are able to impart subject specific knowledge to the students. Whereas, similar to the alumni respondents, many faculties also think that the syllabi requires to be updated to make it more job-oriented. In this connection provisions for more hands-on workouts may be incorporated in the syllabi.
