360-DEGREE HOLISTIC DEVELOPMENT OF STUDENTS



- The students are facilitated to work on relevant problem related to society through PROJECTS on environmental issues, educational status etc.and complex problem solving by SURVEY.
- Students are provided with opportunities to work on environment through regular EDUCATIONAL TOUR to forests, mountains and seas.
- PG and UG students are exposed to various HANDS-ON TRAINING like Harberium Preparation, Dry flower technology, Medical Pathology etc. as add on courses.
- The college signed MoU with the District Industrial Organization (99 industry owners as members) to motivate the students to REACH OUT the INDUSTRY.
- From the last year as pilot project the final semester students can take APPENTICESHIP in two departments and two excellent students of these departments can take INTERNSHIP under the supervision of faculty members.
- Faculty members earnestly assist the students through their preparation for the Common Entrance Test for Post Graduation, JAM,AIIMS, TIFRetc. as CAREER GUIDANCE. The Library support in this regard has enhanced greatly.
- Excellence is practiced by LECTURE SERIES in the form of Memorial lectures during summer vacation each year by all the academic departments by renowned speakers from pioneer institutes of India and abroad through face-to face or online mode. Students keenlylearn about relevant topics belonging to their relevantknowledge-spectrums, which aid their academic understanding and career prospect.

This includes internships, apprenticeships, projects and hands-on experiences that bridges gaps between theory and practice. By engaging in real-world applications of their knowledge, the students not only enhance their practical skills but also develop a deeper understanding of the complexities and nuances of their chosen field-

- INTERNSHIP-UG final semester students for one semester in other institute and current pass-out PG students in the departments of this college for two semesters are engaged in internship. This allows them to apply theoretical knowledge in a professional setting, gain skills and build a network of contacts.
- SERVICE LEARNING- Service learning integrates community service with academic coursework. Students work on projects that address the community needs, gaining practical experience while contributing to the betterment of the society.

- ENTREPRENEURSHIP PROGRAM-The College has Incubation Centre for Innovative Ecosystem(ICIE) of its own where the experience sharing from industrialists, CII-NB Chapter and District Industrial Centre of State Government, MSME of Central Government helps to develop entrepreneurship skills like start up, business management, marketing and finance regularly.
- STUDENT SEMINAR- All the departments organize student seminar in routine in every Saturday, particularly common in fields of science, literature and social sciences.
- FIELD WORK AND SITE VISIT-The college includes field trip and site visit to relevant locations as a part of curriculum tagged as educational tour for all the departments as a routine practice.
- WORKSHOP AND TRAINING SESSIONS-The college organizes workshops and training sessions by almost all the departments, IQAC, Health Centre, NCC and NSS to cover specific skills, tools and techniques relevant to the students' academic interest by the eminent personalities of different fields.
- STUDENT ORGANISATION AND CLUBS- Standard Club, Science Club, Cine Club are the recent set ups where joining can provide opportunities for leadership, team work and practical application of skills.

- ADD-ON COURSE ON PROFESSIONALISM- Department of Philosophy runs 32 hours add on course on Professional Ethics.
- PUBLIC SPEAKING- Department of Political Science shoulders the responsibility to develop public speaking skills by year-round practice on debate, Extempore and Youth Parliament.
- CERTIFICATE COURSE ON ICT- Department of Mathematics familiarizes students with communication tools commonly used in academic and professional settings through the 6 month certificate course approved by the University(CBPBU).
- INTERVIEW SKILL- Career Counseling Cell recently develops interview skill for all final semester students by a professional organization.

Improving communication and interpersonal skills is an ongoing process. Consistent practice and a willingness to learn from experiences will contribute to student's personal and academic success in college and beyond.

- Mental Counseling from Health Centre, Department of Philosophy by professionals and by CMOH, Cooch Behar


- Thalassemia prone region needs thalassemia mapping of all students with support from MJN Medical College & Hospital organized by Health Centre
