Report on the Educational Tour, 2023-24:

The Department of Philosophy conducted an Educational Tour on 27/02/2024 to Raimatang and adjacent riverside Bhatpara Tea Estate, Alipurduar with the participation of 46 students from the 2nd, 4th and 6th Semester Philosophy (Hons.) along with 3 faculty members.

Coochbehar Panchanan Barma University UG Philosophy (Hons.) syllabus includes Environmental Ethics as a separate paper that deals with the human being's ethical relationshipwith the natural environment. Here the fundamental question is-what moral obligation do we have towards our nature.

The main objective of this educational tour was to examine the extent of environmental ethics in river management. The study employed the case study of Raimatang river and the adjoining Bhatpara Tea Estate. The participating students tried to gather data through verbal queries with the local people and the workers of the tea garden.

The study firstly showed that the Raimatang river is considerably polluted and Secondly, it found that though there are several legislations that are already in place, sluggishness in the enforcement of pollution mitigation efforts are responsible for the river pollution. Runoff from the Bhatpara tea plantation carries agrochemicals and fertilizers into nearby Raimatang river water bodies leading to water pollution. As not treated properly, it easily pollutes the freshwater system that it comes into contact with. The toxic chemicals in the water is doing harm to its aquatic life and disrupting ecosystem. It causes the changes of temperature in freshwater systems making them dangerous for many water dwelling organisms. The toxic chemicals in the waste produced by the tea garden have the potential to make water unsafe for human consumption. In order to protect their crops from bacteria and insects tea garden management often use chemicals and pesticides. When these substances seep into the groundwater, they are causing harm to animals, plants and human beings. Additionally, when it rains, the chemicals mixed with rainwater, flows into Raimatang river causing a severe pollution. Hence, posing health threats to those people who really depend on this water resources. Local people are mostly responsible for this pollution as they use river water not with a nature friendly manner. The participating students conversed with them and tried to make them understand that they should take proper care for the river as it is the primary source of water of that area. The study

revealed that cohesive measures must be enforced by the river management agencies to ensure the river is managed well and its water quality controlled.
