

COURSE OF STUDY IN PG CURRICULUM

This college offers both Under Graduate and Post-Graduate courses. Under Graduate courses are offered in two streams , i.e. Science and Arts, whereas Post-Graduate courses are offered in the departments of Bengali, Sanskrit and History under the faculty of Arts and Zoology under the Faculty of Science.

POST GRADUATE COURSE



2-year M.Sc. course in Zoology and 2-year M.A. course in Bengali, Sanskrit and History are offered to the students who have completed their under graduate degree course with **Honours** in the respective subjects.



There are 38 seats in **Bengali, History and Sanskrit** and **32 seats in Zoology**. The admission to those subjects will follow the Cooch Behar Panchanan Barma University (C.B.P.B.U.) Guidelines in this regard.



28% seats (22% for SC and 6% for ST) and 17% seats (10% for OBC-A and 7% for OBC-B) in each subject shall be kept reserved for those category students who will be eligible for admission. If the number of eligible ST candidates falls short of the reserved quota, the vacancies will be filled up by eligible SC candidates and vice-versa. If the number of SC/ST candidates falls short of the quota for them, the candidates of general category may fill up the vacancies after observing necessary procedures.



5% of the seats shall be reserved, for **Specially Challenged / Differently Abled / Physically Challenged** Candidates having not less than **40%** disabilities subject to production of Medical Certificate from appropriate authorities.



EWS (10%) seats shall be reserved.

ELIGIBILITY :

- ❖ Students who have passed B.A./B.SC. Part III (Final Year)/ B.A./B.SC. 6th Semester **Honours** in Bengali, Sanskrit, History and Zoology in 2024 , 2023 & 2022 may apply for M.A./M.Sc. in the aforesaid subjects (without any deductions of marks).Students who became Honours Graduates in the aforesaid subjects before 2022 are not entitled to apply in the M.A./M.Sc. Courses.
- ❖ Out of total number of seats 80% seats are reserved for those students who passed from the college affiliated to Cooch Behar Panchanan Barma University and the rest 20% seats are reserved for **other** Universities including Cooch Behar Panchanan Barma University .
- ❖ 20% of MP's (or equivalent examination) marks obtained + 20% of HS's (or equivalent examination) marks obtained + 60% of UG's marks obtained (Only Honours students are to be eligible to apply in PG courses)

NO APPLICATION FEES WILL BE COLLECTED FROM THE CANDIDATES

REGISTRATION

After admission every student is required to get himself/herself registered with the C.B.P.B.U. Admission of a student migrating from universities other than the C.B.P.B.U., the C.B.P.B.U. remains liable to cancellation of the candidature, if the migration certificate and other necessary documents are not submitted in due time or the C.B.P.B.U. does not approve the migration.

IDENTITY CARD

After admission to the College each student is entitled to get an identity card signed by the Principal and it is a proof of his/her status as a student of this College. Students are required to bring their identity card with them to College and produce it as and when necessary. Loss of identity card must be reported immediately to the office and will be replaced on payment of charges for the same. In case of transfer or withdrawal from the college, the card must be surrendered at the College office.

ATTENDANCE

Name of the student will be struck off if he/she fails to attend 75% of the classes held during the first 10 days of the new academic session. Attendance of at least 75% of the classes held during the course of study is necessary as eligibility for appearing each of the end semester examination conducted by the University. This rule is also applicable to the students appearing in the Continuous Evaluation (e.g. Class tests, Reviews, Assignments, Term Paper Submission, Small Research Project, Students' Seminar, Tutorials etc) tests conducted by the College. Students failing the requirement of minimum attendance will not be allowed to appear at the University Examination.
