

# Structure, Rules, and Design of the Events

## **Make your Message (Message Writing Contest):**

- ❖ The contest is mandatory for all students.
- ❖ Every student must submit a one-line message related to Science, written in their own words, through Google Form (link provided below). The message must not exceed 150 characters. Language shall not be a barrier for this event.

- ❖ Respected H.O.D.s are requested to ensure that every student participates in the event. The deadline for the event is **24<sup>th</sup> February, 11:59 pm**. Submissions after this will not be considered for evaluation.
- ❖ The top **15 messages (1 from each department)**, as judged by the judges' panel, will be rewarded. Names of winners will be declared on **28<sup>th</sup> February, 2026**.

## **Cultivate your Content (Content Scripting Contest):**

- ❖ Three participants from each department must participate in the event.
- ❖ Esteemed H.O.D.s are requested to submit the names of the participants in the prescribed Word file format to be circulated shortly, on or before **24<sup>th</sup> February**. The completed file must be sent via WhatsApp to any one of the following faculty members:

- ❖ The contest will be held from **12 noon on 27<sup>th</sup> February at Abbasuddin Sabhagriha**. Results will be declared on **28<sup>th</sup> February, afternoon**.
- ❖ Participants will be given a topic related to science (not a scientific topic) and they are expected to script their reflections, understanding, observations, arguments on the matter. Participants are to kindly note that innovation is welcome and hence the approach of the creator need not be burdened by pre-determined patterns or generic norms. In other words, the creator is free to intermingle style, modes and medium. However, for sheer practical reasons, use of audio-visual medium is discouraged. The creator can write an argumentative essay, a short story, a personal reflective entry or formulate a graphic essay that would unfurl the provided topic.
- ❖ The topic for the contest would be disclosed on spot.
- ❖ The stipulated time of the contest would be **1 hour**.
- ❖ Please note that in order to encourage originality, special care shall be taken to ensure that the content cultivator has no other aid apart from his own intelligence. So, be prepared to be divorced from your smartphones and other technological friends for one hour.
- ❖ Participants judged **1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>** position in the contest will be awarded.

## The Argumentative Victorian (Debate Competition):

- ❖ The contest shall commence from **11:30 am at Vidyasagar Sabhagriha on 28<sup>th</sup> February.**
- ❖ Every department must send **one** participant for the event.
- ❖ **Esteemed H.O.D.s are requested to submit the name of the participant in the prescribed Word file format to be circulated shortly, on or before 24<sup>th</sup> February. The completed file must be sent via WhatsApp to any one of the following faculty members:**

- ❖ **The topics for the contest shall be disclosed on spot. Topics shall be related to science but not one that is rooted in core scientific knowledge and is exclusive to a particular scientific discipline. Hence, participants from Humanities and Arts departments can rest assured that they are not fighting an uneven battle in any way.**
- ❖ Argumentative depth and novelty, clarity of thought and expression shall be given weightage over discipline-specific scientific knowledge and expertise.
- ❖ **There will be an initial screening round (topic disclosed on spot) where each speaker will speak either for or against the motion (the allotment will be made on the basis of lottery). After the judges have heard all fifteen speakers, a final selection of six speakers will be made by them. The final debate will be held among six speakers (three speakers for the motion and three against the motion—allotment made on the basis of lottery) on a fresh, new topic that will be again disclosed on spot. For the final, along with the judges, there will also be a moderator who will conduct the debate and ensure its smooth progression.**
- ❖ There will be a short re-battle round in the final.
- ❖ **Along with awards for all six finalists, specific rewards of Best speaker shall be reserved for one speaker for the motion and one against the motion.**
- ❖ **The topics for both the screening round and the final round will be disclosed on the spot, 15 minutes prior to the commencement of each round.**
- ❖ To ensure that participants rely solely on their own intelligence, knowledge, and critical thinking skills and to prevent the use of AI-generated ideas, **participants shall not be permitted to use their smartphones or any other electronic devices from the time the topics are disclosed until the completion of the round.**
